DATA & STATISTICS EXPLAINED

GENERAL There are significant margins of error in the data due to a lack of survey respondents. Data will likely change after the 2020 Decennial Census is released. However, even then, it is only
as accurate as how many people complete it. Smaller communities have higher margins of error in their data. Notable data that have high margins of error:
□ Poverty rates, including poverty by age
□ Race and ethnicity
☐ Rent affordability
□ Work status
□ Labor Force Industry Composition
GENERAL Place is referred to as the community/incorporated town or city that is being described (e.g., Bonanza, Chiloquin, etc.). County refers to either Klamath County or Lake County, where the Place is located.
WORK FORCE SECTION Employed is the labor force participation rate in each Place. Labor force participation rate is the sum of all workers who are employed or actively seeking employment.
COMMUTING SECTION Worked outside of County also includes those who worked outside of the state.
LABOR FORCE SECTION The circular graph only includes the percentages of the top three industries in the Place where data was gathered. This is why the percentage points do not equal 100 percent.
